Tournament Format:

This year's format will be four person teams, playing a scramble. Each team will play with another team. Each team is allowed only ONE player with a handicap less than 10 (Eighteen Holes). Handicaps will be verified by GAM or League Secretary. Any change to a team's roster after the auction will eliminate that team from the Calcutta. The field will be split into flights based upon number of teams; those flights will be determined by the scores shot the day of the event. (Example: 30 teams = 3 flights of 10 teams)

Auction

Auction minimum bid \$100.00 and \$600.00 maximum, but you can purchase your own team for half the bid price (\$300.00 max). A team has the first option to purchase themselves for \$600.00 at the start of bidding for their team. If they don't take the option, then it is open bidding.

Event Scoring

Ties will be broken by a sudden death playoff on the scorecard starting at the number one handicap hole.

Example: Two teams tie for last place in the first flight. Team A has a 3 on Hole #7, Team B has
4. Because Team A had the better score, Team A stays in the <u>first</u> flight and Team B wins first place <u>second</u> flight.
